Ragging

A Violation of Human Rights

Introduction:

As per the definition described under UGC's Anti Ragging squad:

1. Any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or a junior student.

DIST-NADIA

- 2 Anyone indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or Psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student.
- 3. Asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not o in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or Psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

Humble Supreme Court of India, during December 2007 has expressed concern over the incidents of ragging occurring in higher educational institutions and the need to eliminate it altogether.

The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India has taken a serious note of the incidents of ragging and is of the view that stern action should be taken against those indulging in "ragging" so that these incidents are not repeated and exemplary punishment is meted out to those indulging in it. Strict implementation of the guidelines issued by Hon'ble Supreme Court on this issue has also been stressed by the Ministry.

Ragging is a criminal offence and lowers the standards of education. The 'anti-ragging policy' adopted by the Institute takes care of preventive, procedural and punitive aspects of ragging based on the guidelines provided by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, recommendations of the Raghavan Committee, instructions/guidelines issued by the Ministry of HRD (Govt. of India).

Establishment: The anti ragging squad of the college is in function from the academic year of 2018-19.

Objective of the squad:

- 1. To create a ragging free environment in the institution
- 2. To main the ethics and code of conduct of the college

- 3. To look into the matters of the ragging complaints
- 4. To take initiative steps for creating awareness and measures for discouraging ragging

Anti-Ragging Policy:

This policy is developed to encourage socialization of students to the academic environment of the institute, simultaneously discouraging and preventing any negative acts on parts of senior students, which goes against the basic purpose of socio-academic integration. The 'Anti-ragging policy' adopted by the Institute therefore is aimed at:

- 1. Creating, developing and nurturing a conducive, socio-academic environment within the student population.
- 2. Building a high level of confidence within newly admitted and their parents/guardians to see that the newly admitted are welcomed in the Institutions by their seniors.
- 3. To discourage and prevent any negative acts like 'ragging' by the seniors, which disrupts socio-academic integration of new entrants.
- 4. Framing and updating rules for any violation of the "Anti-Ragging Policy" keeping in view of building a healthy environment.

Preventive Measures Initiated by the Institution:

- 1. Formation of Anti-Ragging Squad consisting of two/three faculty members
- 2. Drop-box facility where the victim can complain anonymously
- 3. Online complain box has also been provided in the website
- 4. The campus is extensively under CCTV surveillance to discourage such unlawful activities
- 5. Posters against practising Ragging are displayed all around the college campus
- 6. Students can approach all the staffs of the institution if he/she is facing any ragging in any form.

Penalties for Ragging:

Prohibiting from representation of events.

- Withholding results
- Rusticate from Institute.
- Debarring from examination/s.
- Suspension from the institute or class for a limited period.
- Fine with public apology.
- Prosecuting for criminal offence.
- Filing FIR with the local police.
- Cancellation of admission
