

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

### FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF ACADEMIC COOPERATION IN COLLEGE EDUCATION

The general objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to stimulate and facilitate the development of collaborative and mutually beneficial programs which serve to enhance the intellectual life and cultural development on both campuses, and to contribution to increased inter-college cooperation. Thus, **Bethuadahari College** and **Chapra Bangaljhi Mahavidyalaya** have agreed that in support of their mutual interests in the field of education and research:

- 1) The two Educational Institutions will:
  - a) cooperate in the exchange of information relating to their activities in teaching and research in fields of mutual interests;
  - b) promote appropriate joint research projects and joint courses of study, with particular emphasis on internationally funded projects;
  - c) endeavor to encourage students and staff to spend periods of time in the host College. The exchange of students will be dependent on the execution of a formal Student Exchange Agreement prior to commencement of this activity;
  - d) conduct short courses, as mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to commencement of this activity;
  - e) conduct cultural projects, a, mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to commencement of this activity;
  - f) conduct study tours, a, mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to commencement of this activity.
- 2) Accreditation for the academic work carried out by an undergraduate student during the period of study at the host College will be at the discretion of the student's home College.
- 3) Admission to a specific department or course is subject Only to a student being satisfactorily qualified for the chosen area of study and to the availability of resources in the period for which admission is sought.
- 4) The aim of the Memorandum of Understanding shall be to achieve a broad balance in the respective contributions and benefits of the collaboration, and this shall be subject to periodic review by both Colleges.

- 5) All other financial matters, including travel costs, are subject to individual negotiation, and will normally be the responsibility of the persons involved and their home institution.
- 6) The host institution agrees to assist in supplying work space, library and technical facilities as appropriate.

This agreement will take effect from 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2017 to 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2023 (for Six Years) unless sooner terminated, revoked or modified by mutual written agreement between the Parties, and may be extended by mutual written agreement.

Either party may terminate the Agreement at any time during the term by the provision of three months written notice to the other party.
